## NOTICE OF RACE



### GENERAL INFORMATION

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### 1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by the 2018 North-America RS Tera Class Rules, and by the 2018 RS Tera California Series Notice of Series.
- 1.2 RRS 82 will not apply.
- 1.3 A condition of entry and participation in this regatta is the wearing of a U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket, properly secured at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while removing or adding clothing. All lifejackets must be suitable for the competitor's weight. Wet suits, dry suits, and inflatable lifejackets do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy. These changes are added to rule 40, and the Preamble to Part 4 will not apply to rule 40.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to RS Tera class boats.
- 2.2 Eligible competitors may enter their boat by having their parent or guardian complete online registration at [www.calyachtclub.com/Junior-Sailing](http://www.calyachtclub.com/Junior-Sailing) and pay all fees by 1030 on Saturday May 12. Entries submitted after that time may be accepted only with the approval of the Regatta Chair and will be charged a \$10 late fee.

### 3. CHECK-IN

- 3.1 Check-in will be in on the CYC Junior Sailing Center patio between 0900 and 1030 on Saturday, May 12.
- 3.2 Check-in includes completing registration and paying all fees.

### 4. FEES

The entry fee is \$20 for entries received by 1030 on Saturday, May 12 (Entry Deadline).

### 5. REGATTA FORMAT & SCORING

- 5.1 The regatta format will be determined on Thursday May 10 and posted on the CYC Juniors Sailing webpage. It will be based on the number of entries and the weather conditions
- 5.2 The low point system Appendix A of the RRS will be used. When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 5.3 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

### 6. SCHEDULE

Seven (7) races are scheduled. The RC, at its discretion, may run fewer races. There will be a lunch break.

### 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be posted on CYC Junior webpage by Thursday, May 10 after 6PM and printed copies will be available at Check-in. Course Charts will be available at Check-in.

### 8. VENUE

Racing will be conducted inside Marina del Rey harbor; racing areas to be assigned.

### 9. THE COURSES

The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

### 10. DESIGNATED ADULT

- 10.1 An adult (parent, guardian or designated adult) is responsible for the safety of each competitor. It is solely the responsibility of this adult to decide if the competitor should sail in the weather and sea conditions that might arise during the event. The adult supervising the competitor is ultimately responsible for the risks. Additionally, this

designated adult shall accept full responsibility for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

- 10.2 Any parent or guardian not personally attending any part of the event shall provide, during online registration, the name and contact information for the adult that is authorized and designated to be responsible for their child during this event per NoR 10.1.

#### **11. COACH / SUPPORT BOATS**

- 11.1 Coach/support boats must register with the RC. Only registered coach/support boats will be allowed in the racing area.
- 11.2 All coach/support boats must carry and monitor a VHF radio. All individuals on such registered boats are required to wear PFDs.
- 11.3 The conduct of registered coach/support boats, all other support boats, and support persons will be governed by the Sailing Instructions.
- 11.4 Coach/support and spectator boats shall not be launched or recovered at CYC while competitors are launching or recovering their dinghies.
- 11.5 Competitors who wish to launch coach/support boats at CYC must make arrangements with the Dockmaster for use of the hoist and trailer storage.

#### **12. PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible after racing.

#### **13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By participating in this regatta, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers (organizing authority, host yacht club, race committee, protest committee, sponsors, and any others acting in an official capacity for this event) from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this regatta to the fullest extent permitted by law.
