7. MARKS

7.1 The starting mark will be Mark S, with the starting line between the course side of Mark S and the staff displaying an orange and white flag on the port side of the RC signal vessel.

7.2 Marks H through V are yellow or white spar buoys. Marks 1 and 2 are orange tetrahedrons. Offset Mark is a yellow tetrahedron. In the event a spar buoy is missing or off position, an inflatable tetrahedron may be used as a replacement. Their approximate locations are shown below:

- H Mark: 33°57.367'N 118°28.655'W
- S Mark: 33°57.187'N 118°29.216'W
- SS Mark: 33°57.547'N 118°28.093'W
- V Mark: 33°57.007'N 118°29.777'W
- Mark 1: 33°57.850'N 118°28.950'W
- Mark 2: 33°56.900'N 118°28.450'W
- Offset Mark: 33°57.333'N 118°27.412'W

8. COURSES (continued)

8.1 Marks shall be rounded to port.

8.2 All boats shall sail the same course. No later than the warning signal for each class, the RC signal vessel will use number pennants to signal one of the courses shown below:

Number	Courses	Distance
1	Start (at S) – SS – Mark 1 – S – Mark 2 – Mark 1 – H– SS – S – SS – Mark 1 – Mark 2 – Offset -- Finish	9.9 nm
2	Start (at S) – SS – Mark 1 – V – Mark 2 – Mark 1 – H– SS – V – SS – Mark 1 – Mark 2 – Offset -- Finish	11.6 nm
3	Start (at S) – SS – Mark 1 – V – Mark 2 – Mark 1 – H– SS – V – SS – Mark 1 – Mark 2 – V -- Offset -- Finish	13.7 nm
