Los Angeles Yacht Club® Mooring Reservation Procedures for Club-To-Club Members at Howlands Cove, Catalina

- 1) Requests for mooring reservations should be directed to the designated party at each CTC Club. Do not call the LAYC® office.
- 2) Mooring reservation periods run from Friday through Thursday nights of each week from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. All boats on moorings with reservations made for the week prior must vacate the mooring Friday morning.
- 3) The CTC Club will provide a list of its members, in order of priority, to the LAYC Office not later than Noon each Wednesday. Lists should be sent to office@layc.org with a copy to manager@layc.org. The office phone number is 310-831-1203. The order of priority by which moorings will be assigned is to be established by the CTC Club.
- 4) The priority list will contain the following information:
- Boat owner/operators name
- Boat owners/operators phone number
- Boat owner/operators e-mail address
- Arrival and departure dates
- Name of boat
- Type of boat (power/sail)
- Length of boat
- Document or CF number
- 5) If a mooring reservation is available, LAYC will assign it in accordance with the terms of the CTC Agreement.
- 6) LAYC will notify the CTC Club and the boat/owner operator by 2PM on Thursday if a reservation was available and the mooring number.
- 7) Boat owners intending to use the Camp pier at Howland's Landing must have an identification tag issued by LAYC. This will be available at each CTC Club.
- 8) The Harbor Patrol is the ultimate authority in the cove, and officer instructions must be followed under all circumstances.
